



# Internal partitions

### Office division.

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Among the many possibilities for dividing interior spaces, **Exlabesa** offers a simple and versatile aluminium system that can hold one or two separating elements.

When it comes to modulating the space in an office or industrial space, an internal partition with two functions is usually sought: acoustic insulation and visual control. Flexible systems are needed that provide the right property at each point, combining thin elements such as glass and panels with louvres blinds and insulating materials. Of course, the door element is also necessary.



## **TECHNICAL FEATURES**

#### Types

The system is divided into two main types: single or double. The first option is the most basic: a single transparent, opaque or translucent layer will have to provide the desired functions.

The double inner partition has more possibilities. The 40 mm between the two layers allows the installation of louvred blinds in the case of glazing and thermal insulation in the blind panels if required.

#### Aesthetics

Once again, this is a versatile system that allows complete freedom. The presence of the profiles can be reduced to 22 mm and the modulation can be vertical, horizontal, crossed... It is often useful to configure a parapet to hide low furniture or a lintel to finish off a false ceiling.

However, the most important element is the panel itself.

#### Panels

With opaque panels all options are possible: wood, aluminium, sandwich panel or composite panel.



#### Visual control

The louvred shutter marks the image when it is installed, although the use of vinyl on the glass to restrict visual contact is becoming more and more common.
